Here you are. Enjoy your meal.

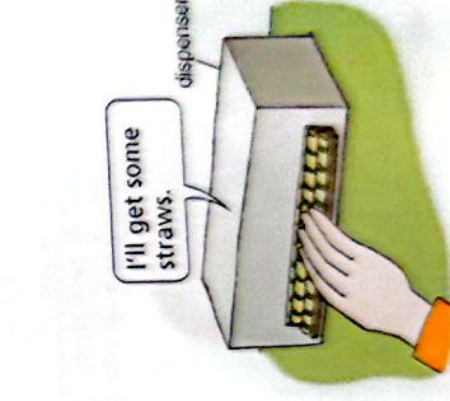
The cashier gives them their food.
