- **pass:** to hand; to give
- **usher:** (sb) working in a theater who takes tickets and tells people where to go
- **stub:** a part torn from a ticket

- ¹ I heard that movie is good.
= That movie got good reviews.
- ² It is on your left. = It is to the left.

Let's sit in the middle.

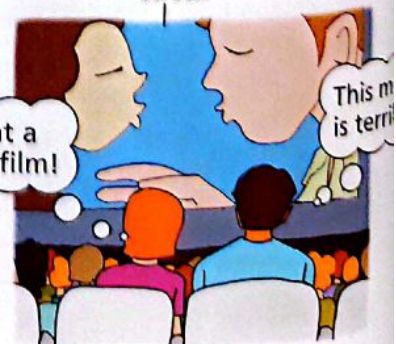


They choose a place to sit.
