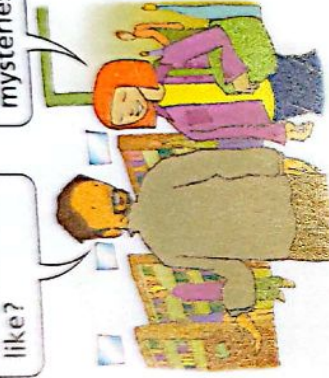
- call number: the identifying library number of a book

They walk down the aisle.

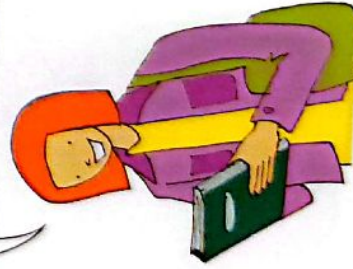
Here it is!
